#### Tips from our Counselor, Ms. Jessica

This month in classroom counseling, we will be learning about growth mindset. Growth mindset refers to the idea that abilities and intelligence can be developed by having a positive attitude, practicing, and viewing mistakes/challenges as opportunities to grow. Not only have scientific studies proven the power of a growth mindset, they have also found a correlation between the type of praise students receive and their development of a growth mindset. Praise focusing on telling a student they are smart encourages a fixed mindset whereas praising a student's effort and process encourages a growth mindset. Here are some ways we can change our language:

Instead of This (outcome praise)	Try This (process praise)
Great job! You must be smart at this!	Great job! You must have worked really hard.
All of your answers are right, great work!	When you were working on this problem, you used different strategies to get the answer. Great Work!
Nice drawing!	I noticed you really took your time drawing that picture. Well done!
