Tips from our Counselor, Ms. Jessica

This month in classroom counseling, we will be focusing on creating SMART goals. A SMART goal is Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Realistic, and Timely. Knowing how to set goals is an important life skill that will help your child succeed in school and also in life. Here are some tips on how to help your child set their own goals!

- Have your child write down a goal they want to achieve and place it where they will see it regularly such as the refrigerator.
- Work together to develop a plan on how they will achieve their goal such as setting up daily "homework time" or a "study space" or breaking down a large goal into smaller goals.
- Be flexible if your child doesn't reach their goal. Encourage them to try again and help them adjust their goal if it proves too difficult or too easy.
- Set a good example by writing your own SMART goal. Not only will your child learn by observation, but their self esteem can increase if they are involved in the process of your goal creation and completion as well as their own!
