We are asking that all kinder and first grade families utilize this entrance. Beginning March 2nd, the second location will open. The second location is located on Olivehurst Ave, where lunch distribution occurs. To enter campus, all students must take part in a health screening where temperatures will be taken. Check in stations are open from 8:00am—8:30am. The entrance near the main office will remain open until 9:00am for those students who are tardy. After 9:00, students will need to check in at the main office. We are excited to safely welcome our students back on campus!

The B cohort will be on campus Thursday and Friday. Students in the C cohort will continue with distance learning and will not be on campus. All students will continue to learn daily and be required to complete daily assignments and check ins.
